Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu General Service.

No. SRO B-68/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu General Service (Section 16 in Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual).

AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules-

(1) in Part I, for the expression "Class XLIV-Legal Advisor to the Deputy Inspector-General of Police (C.I.D.), Chennai" the following expression shall be substituted, namely:-

"Class XLIV-Legal Advisor in the Crime Branch Criminal Investigation Department, Chennai.";

(2) in Part II, for the heading "Class XLIV - Legal Advisor to the Deputy Inspector - General of Police (C.I.D.), Chennai" and the rules thereunder, the following heading and rules shall be substituted, namely:-

"Class XLIV - Legal Advisor in the Crime Branch Criminal Investigation Department, Chennai.

1. *Constitution.*-This Class shall consist of the Post of Legal Advisor in the Crime Branch Criminal Investigation Department, Chennai.

2. *Appointment.*- Appointment to the post shall be made by transfer from among the holders of the Post of Assistant Public Prosecutor, Grade-I in Class XLIX of the Tamil Nadu General Service.

3. *Postings.*- Postings to the post on return from leave shall be made by Additional Director General of Police, Crime Branch C.I.D."

Amendments to the Ad-hoc Rules relating to the Temporary Post of Assistant Public Relations Officer (Publicity) in the Information Wing of Tamil Development and Information Department in Tamil Nadu General Subordinate Services.

No. SRO B-69/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso of Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the rules published with the Information, Tourism (Tamil) Culture Department. Notification No. SRO B-60/82, at Pages 76-77 of Part III—Section 1(b) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated 17th February 1982.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Ad-hoc Rules-

(1) for rule 3 the following shall be substituted.

(i) "Appointment to the post shall be made by direct recruitment or by promotion from the post of Cinema Operator or Journal Assistant or Mono Keyboard Operator or Photo Type Setting Operator or recruitment by transfer from the post of Reporter from Tamilarasu Office."

(ii) Pattern of Appointment:- Out of every 10 vacancies in the category of Assistant Public Relations Officer (Publicity), appointment shall be made in the following order of rotation:-

- (1) by direct recruitment;
- (2) by promotion from post of Cinema Operator;
- (3) by direct recruitment;
- (4) by promotion from post of Journal Assistant;
- (5) by direct recruitment;

- (6) by promotion from post of Mono Keyboard Operator;
 (7) by direct recruitment;
 (8) by promotion from post of Photo Type Setting Operator;
 (9) by direct recruitment;
 (10) by transfer from the post of Reporter from Tamilarasu Office.

2. In rule 6 in sub-rule (b) for the table and the entries thereunder, the following Table shall be substituted.

(ii) Experience in the respective category <i>i.e.</i> , in the post of Cinema Operator or Journal Assistant or Mono Keyboard Operator or Photo Type Setting Operator for a period of not less than four years. (iii) Knowledge of Computer and Typewriting both in Tamil and English is preferable.
3 Transfer from the post of Reporter from Tamilarasu Office.	(i) Must hold a Bachelor's Degree of any university recognized by the UGC for the purpose of its grants. (ii) Experience in Public Relations for a period of not less than four years; (iii) Knowledge of Computer and Typewriting both in the Tamil and English is preferable.

Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu General Subordinate Services

[G.O. Ms. No. 212, Tourism, Culture and Religious Endowments (MA1) 27th September 2017, புரட்டாசி 11, ஹேவிளம்பி, திருவள்ளூர் ஆண்டு-2048.]

No. SRO B-70/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu General Subordinate Service (Section 13 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1970).

AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules, in PART II, under "CLASS II - GOVERNMENT MUSEUMS",-

(1) in rule 2, in the "TABLE", for the entry in column (2) against the Category "4.Taxidermists Grade I" in column (1) thereof, the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

- (i) Direct recruitment;
 (ii) Promotion from category 5:

Provided that appointment to the post by the methods (i) and (ii) above shall be made in the ratio of 1 :2.;

(2) after rule 5, the following rules shall be inserted, namely:-

"5A.Training.-Every person appointed to the category of Taxidermists Grade I or Taxidermists Grade II by direct recruitment shall undergo the Taxidermy training conducted by the Government Museum, Chennai within the period of his probation.

5B.Test.—Every person appointed to the category of Taxidermists Grade I or Taxidermists Grade II by direct recruitment must pass the test conducted by the Zoology section of the Government Museum, Chennai for the skill in preparing wax moulds and plaster casting of Specimens, before completion of probation”;

(3) In the ANNEXURE,-

(i) for the entries in columns (2) and (3) against the category 4 “Taxidermists Grade I” in column (1) thereof, the following entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:-

“Direct Recruitment	(1) Must possess B.Sc. degree in Zoology;
Promotion	(1) Must have passed the S.S.L.C;
	(2) Must have worked as Taxidermist Grade II for a period of not less than two years;
	(3) Must have undergone the Taxidermy training conducted by the Government Museum, Chennai or any other Government Institution; and
	(4) Must have passed the test conducted by the Zoology Section of the Government Museum, Chennai for the skill in preparing Wax moulds and plaster casting of Specimens.”;

(ii) for the entries in columns (2) and (3) against the category 5 “Taxidermists Grade II” in column (1) thereof, the following entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:-

“Direct Recruitment	(1) Must have passed the S.S.L.C;
	(2) Must possess a Higher Grade Certificate in Painting, Drawing or Modeling awarded by the Director of Technical Education, Tamil Nadu.
Promotion or Recruitment by transfer	(1) Must have passed the S.S.L.C;
	(2) Must possess a Higher Grade Certificate’ in Painting, Drawing or Modeling awarded by the Director of Technical Education, Tamil Nadu;
	(3) Must have undergone the Taxidermy Training conducted by the Government Museum, Chennai or any other Government Institution;
	(4) Must have passed the test conducted by the Zoology section of the Government Museum, Chennai for skill in preparing Wax moulds and plaster casting of Specimens; and
	(5) Must have put in service as Attender for a period of not less than two years.”
