Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Engineering Service.

No. SRO B-76/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Engineering Service. (Section 38 in Volume—II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1969).

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on and from 19th September, 2016.

AMENDMENTS

1. In rule 2,

(i) In sub-rule (a), in the Table,-

(a) In column (3), against the expression “Class IV” in column (1) and the expression “Assistant Executive Engineer (Agricultural Engineering)” in column (2) thereof, the expression, “(i) by direct recruitment” shall be omitted;

(b) item “(ii)” shall be re-numbered as item “(i)”;

(c) item “(iii)” shall be re-numbered as item “(ii)”;

(ii) For sub-rule (b), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely :-

“(b) Appointment to vacancies arising in Class IV shall be made by promotion from among the holders of the Post of Assistant Engineer in Class V and by recruitment by transfer from among the holders of the post of Junior Engineer in the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Subordinate Service in the ratio of 3 : 1 and shall be filled up in the following order of rotation, namely:-

(i) By Promotion;

(ii) By recruitment by transfer;

(iii) By Promotion; and

(iv) By Promotion

2. In rule 5, for the expression “to the Posts of Assistant Executive Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) and Assistant Engineer (Agricultural Engineering)”, the expression “to the Post of Assistant Engineer (Agricultural Engineering)” shall be substituted.

3. In rule 6, in sub-rule (a) in the TABLE, the entry “Class IV” in column (1) and the corresponding entry “32 years” in column (2) thereof shall be omitted.

4. In rule 7,-

(i) sub-rule (a) shall be omitted;

(ii) sub-rule “(b)” shall be re-numbered as sub-rule “(a)” of that rule;

(iii) (a) sub-rule “(c)” shall be re-numbered as sub-rule “(b)” of that rule;

(b) in sub-rule (b) as so re-numbered, the expression “Assistant Executive Engineer (or)” shall be omitted;

(iv) sub-rule (d) shall be omitted.

5. In rule 8, in sub-rule (a), the expression “by direct recruitment or” shall be omitted;

6. In the Annexure for the entries in columns (2) and (3), against the expression “CLASS-IV Assistant Executive Engineer (Agricultural Engineering)” in column (1) thereof, the following entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:

“(i) By promotion from among the holders of the post in Class V

1. Service for a total period of not less than three years in the post of Assistant Engineer (Agricultural Engineering)
2. A pass in the following tests, namely:-
 - (a) Account Test for Public Works Department Officers and Subordinates;
 - (b) Departmental Test for Officers of the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Department; and
 - (c) District Office Manual Test :

Provided that a pass in the Account Test for Public Works Department Officers and Subordinates shall not be necessary, if he has already passed the Account Test for Subordinate Officers, Part I and II.

“(ii) By recruitment by transfer from among the holder of the post of Junior Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) in the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Subordinate Service

1. A Diploma in Agricultural Engineering or a Diploma in Civil or Mechanical Engineering;
2. Service for a total period of not less than three years as Junior Engineer (Agricultural Engineering);
3. A pass in the following tests, namely:-
 - (a) Account Test for Public Works Department Officers and Subordinates;
 - (b) Departmental test for Officers of the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Department; and
 - (c) District Office Manual Test:

Provided that a pass in the Account Test for Public Works Department Officers and Subordinates shall not be necessary, if he has already passed the Account Test for Subordinate Officers, Part I and II.”

Amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Police Subordinate Service.

No. SRO B-77/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 8 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu District Police Act, 1859 (Central Act XXIV of 1859) and Sections 9 and 11 of the Chennai City Police Act, 1888 (Tamil Nadu Act III of 1888) read with the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Police Subordinate Service (Section 34 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1986).

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the **13th July 1995**.

AMENDMENT

In the said Special Rules, in rule 25, in sub-rule (a), after the fifth proviso, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

“Provided also that the seniority of the Sub-Inspectors of Police directly recruited under the departmental quota shall be fixed above the persons directly recruited under open quota in the same recruitment”.
