Errata to Notification

(Rc. No. K-38/1/2017/TNeGA)

The following Errata are issued to the Commissionerate of e-Governance Notification No. SRO C-27/2017, Published at pages 144-146 of Part III—Section 2 of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* issue No. 43, dated 25th October 2017.

ERRATA

In the said notification,-

(1) The title shall be read as:—

Under Section 57 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (Central Act 18 of 2016) for the State Resident Data Hub (SRDH) Portal (<http://makkal.tn.gov.in>)

(2) after the title, the 1st Paragraph shall be read as:-

WHEREAS, the National Population Register (NPR) is a Register of usual residents of the country, which is being prepared at the local (Village/sub-Town), sub-District, District, State and National level under the provisions of the Citizenship Act, 1955 (Central Act No. 57 of 1955) and the Citizenship (Registration of Citizens and issue of National Identity Cards) Rules, 2003 and hence it is an authenticated database. It is mandatory for every usual resident of India to register in the NPR. A usual resident is defined for the purposes of NPR as a person who has resided in a local area for the past six months or more or a person who intends to reside in that area for the next six months or more;

(3) the 2nd Paragraph of page No. 144 shall be read as:-

AND WHEREAS, 'State Resident Data Hub' has been created by the Government of Tamil Nadu as a secure, unified, digitized data repository derived from the National Population Register to service all departments and it is envisaged as the single source of data for Tamil Nadu State's residents including address and has provision for Aadhaar authentication and it will help the Government in better targeting, effective service delivery, greater accountability and more efficient monitoring of schemes;

(4) the 6th Paragraph in page No. 144 shall be read as:-

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the provisions of Section 57 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (Central Act 18 of 2016), the Commissioner of e-Governance and Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency hereby authorizes the use of Aadhaar number for establishing the identity of an individual for purpose specified hereunder:-

(5) after 6th Paragraph the point No. (1), (2) & (3) shall be read as:-

- (1) All residents who wish to avail the services of the 'State Resident Data Hub (SRDH)' portal (<http://makkal.tn.gov.in>) are required to furnish proof of possession of Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.
- (2) Such residents of Tamil Nadu desirous of correcting or changing their demographic details like name, age, Gender, address etc. to avail the services offered by various departments of the Government of Tamil Nadu are hereby required to provide their Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication and then correct their demographic details in the 'State Resident Data Hub (SRDH)' portal (<http://makkal.tn.gov.in>) in any of the e-Sevai Centres by furnishing any documents listed in the Annexure as proof of identity and proof of address.

- (3) Any change or correction in the demographic details made in the State Resident Data Hub (SRDH), shall be shared with departments mentioned hereunder with the resident's consent so that the saved changes can also be carried out in the databases of the respective departments with their concurrence:-
- (i) Civil Supplies Department - Public distribution scheme card
 - (ii) Election - Electoral Photo Identity card
 - (iii) Transport - Driving license
 - (iv) Treasuries and Accounts - Pension
 - (v) Welfare of Differently-Abled Persons Department
 - (vi) Other Departments requiring such data for implementing their schemes
