#### Amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Secretariat Service.

[G.O. Ms. No. 33, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (D2), 15th March 2018, பங்குனி 1, ஹேவிளம்பி, திருவள்ளுவர் ஆண்டு–2049.]

No. SRO B-36/2018.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Secretariat Service (Section 29 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Service Manual, 1986):—

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 23rd June 2015.

#### **AMENDMENT**

In the said Special Rules, in rule 14, in the "TABLE", against the entry "Category 3A Assistants (Translations)" in column (1) and the entry "Direct recruitment or transfer from any other category or recruitment by transfer from any other service" in column (2) thereof, for the entry "(i) Minimum general educational qualification prescribed in Schedule-III to the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 (Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 2016); and" in column (3), the following entry shall be substituted, namely:—

"(i) A Bachelor's Degree with Tamil as one of the subjects:

Provided that preference shall be given to a candidate who is able to read and write in Hindi or Malayalam or Telugu Language; and".
