conferred by Section 16 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act,
1882 (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1882), the Governor of
Tamil Nadu hereby declares the area, the boundaries of
which are specified in the Schedule below, as reserve forest
with effect on and from the 28-11-2018.

(Ms) No.127, Environment and Forests (FR.14) Department, dated 14-6-2002] starts from junction point of northern boundary of Survey Field Number 695 towards northern direction and turns to north east, direction and turns to eastern direction and turns to northern direction and turns north east direction towards junction point of Survey Field Number 1256 and Survey Field Number 695 (part) of Sirumalai Village. This cart track has been in existence prior to the publication of notification under Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882 and therefore the Forest Settlement Officer, Dindigul has permitted this cart track right in this suo-motu claim No.595/2009 dated 6-8-2009.
