Ad hoc Rules relating to the Temporary Post of Demonstrator (Yoga) in Government Yoga and Naturopathy Medical College, Chennai in Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy in Tamil Nadu Medical Service.

No. SRO B-65/2018.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Rules:-

RULES

The provisions contained in the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 (Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 2016) and the Special Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent posts in of class I of Branch-I-Medical of the Tamil Nadu Medical service shall apply to the holders of the temporary post of Demonstrator (Yoga) in Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy Department sanctioned from time to time, subject to the modifications specified in the following Rules:—

2. Constitution:— The post shall constitute a separate category in the said class of said service.

3. Appointment:— Appointment to the post shall be made by direct recruitment.

4. Qualification:— (a) Age.- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by direct recruitment, if he has completed or will complete 35 years of age on the 1st day of July of the year, in which the selection for the appointment is made.

(b) Other Qualifications:— No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post unless he possesses the following qualifications, namely: —

(i) Must have passed a Degree in Naturopathy and Yogic Science (BNYS) or Diploma in Naturopathy with not less than four and half years academic duration awarded by a recognized University; and

(ii) Must have registered with the Tamil Nadu Board of Indian medicine, Government of Tamil Nadu under Class A Practitioner.

5. Reservation of Appointment:— The Principle of reservation of appointment provided in Section 27 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 (Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 2016) shall apply for appointment to the post by direct recruitment.

6. Probation:— Every person appointed to the post by direct recruitment shall from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

7. Tests:-(a) Every person appointed to the post, shall within the period of probation pass the Account Test for Executive Officers; and

(b) The Departmental Test in the Tamil Nadu Medical Code within a period of four years from the date of appointment to the post, failing which his increment in the time scale of pay applicable to the post shall be postponed without cumulative effect till he passes the said tests.

8. Private Practice:- The holders of the post shall be allowed consulting practice:

Provided that if he acts as an Inspecting Medical Officer in the Directorate of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, he shall not be allowed for private practice.

9. Appointing Authority:— The appointing authority for the post shall be the Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy.

10. Pay:— There shall be paid to the holders of the post, a monthly pay calculated in the revised scale of pay level 22-56100-177500.
