(2) for the figure "1,00,000" in column (3) against the entry "Death while fishing or Immediately thereafter not due to Accident" in column (2), the figure "2,00,000" shall be substituted.

(3) for the figure "1,00,000" in column (3) against the entry "Missing fisherman while fishing" in column (2), the figure "2,00,000" shall be substituted.

Explanations.- Dearness Allowance.- (1) In addition to the minimum rates of basic wages fixed above, the employees shall be Paid dearness allowance as indicated below:-

- (i) The dearness allowance is linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the year 2010, that is 161 points (with base 2001=100) and for every raise of one point over and above 161 points, an increase of Rs.57.35 (Rupees fifty seven and paise thirty five only) per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.
- (ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated every year on the first April, on the basis of the average

of the consumer price indices for the preceeding twelve months, that is, from January to December.

(iii) The first calculation shall thus be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* based on the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index Number for the previous year.

- (2) Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made between men and women employees.
- (3) To arrive at daily rates of wages, the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.
- (4) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the same shall be continued to be paid.
