HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE DEPARTMENT**Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Food Safety Subordinate Service**

No. SRO B-86/2018.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Food Safety Subordinate Service, which shall form part as Section 61 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual.

RULES.

1. These rules may be called as the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Food Safety Subordinate Service.
2. The rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 22nd December 2011.

2. **Constitution.**- The service shall consist of the following posts, which are classified as Technical namely:-

- (1) Junior Analyst
- (2) Laboratory Technician, Grade-I
- (3) Laboratory Technician, Grade-II
- (4) Electrician

3. **Appointment.**- Appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below shall be made by the methods specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof:-

<i>Posts</i> (1)	<i>Method of Appointment.</i> (2)
(1) Junior Analyst	(i) By direct recruitment; or (ii) by promotion from the post of Laboratory Technician, Grade-I; Provided that appointment by direct recruitment and by promotion shall be made in the ratio of 4: 1
(2) Laboratory Technician, Grade-I	by promotion from the post of Laboratory Technician, Grade-II
(3) Laboratory Technician, Grade-II	by direct recruitment.
(4) Electrician	by direct recruitment.

4. **Appointing Authority.**- The appointing authority for the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below shall be the authorities specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof:-

5. **Qualifications.**- (a). **Age** No person shall be eligible for appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below by direct recruitment, if he has completed or will complete the age specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.

6. Reservation of Appointment.- The Rule relating to reservation of appointments (General Rule 22) shall apply for appointment to the posts by direct recruitment.

7. Probation.- Every person appointed to the posts by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

8. Test.- Every person appointed to the post of Junior Analyst shall pass the Account test for Subordinate Officers, Parts I and II within the period of his probation.

9. Preparation of annual list of approved candidates and crucial date.- For the purpose of preparation of annual list of approved candidates for appointment to the posts by direct recruitment or by promotion, on which the candidate should be qualified shall be the 15th February of every year.

10. Pay.- There shall be paid to the holders of the following posts, a monthly pay calculated in the Pay Band and Grade Pay indicated below:-

No. SRO B-87/2018.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Rules:-

2. The Rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on and from 22nd December 2011.

RULES

The General Rules for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Service and the Special Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent posts in the Tamil Nadu Food Safety Subordinate Service shall apply to the holders of the Temporary posts sanctioned from time to time, subject to the modifications specified below, namely:-

1. Constitution.- The following posts shall constitute a separate category in a distinct class of the said service classified as Technical namely:-

Posts

- (1) Statistical Assistant
- (2) Food Safety Officer

2. Appointment.- Appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below shall be made by the methods specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof:

3. Appointing Authority.- The appointing authority for the posts of Statistical Assistant and Food Safety Officer shall be the Commissioner of Food Safety and Drug Administration.

4. Qualification.- (a).Age No person shall be eligible for appointment to the posts by direct recruitment, if he has completed or will complete the age of 30 years on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment in made.

(b). **Other Qualifications.-** No person shall be eligible for appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below by the methods specified in column (2) of the Table below, unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof:-

5. Reservation of Appointment.- The Rule relating to reservation of appointments (General Rule 22) shall apply for appointment to the posts by direct recruitment.

6. Probation.- Every person appointed to the post by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years:

Provided that for the persons appointed to the post of Statistical Assistant by recruitment by transfer shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.

7. Test.- Every person appointed to the post of Food Safety Officer by direct recruitment shall pass the test of Account test for Executive Officers within the period of probation.

8. Preparation of annual list of approved candidates and crucial date.-For the purpose of preparation of annual list of approved candidates for appointment to the post either by direct recruitment or by recruitment by transfer, on which the candidate should be qualified shall be the 15th February of every year.

9. Pay.- There shall be paid to the holders of the following posts, a monthly pay calculated in the pay Band and Grade Pay indicated below:-
