Amendment to the Tamil Nadu Special Police Youth Brigade Rules, 2013.

[G.O. Ms. No. 1919, Home (Pol.14), 10th October 2018].

No. SRO A-56/2018.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 12 of the Tamil Nadu Special Police Youth Brigade Act, 2013 (Tamil Nadu Act 3 of 2013), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Tamil Nadu Special Police Youth Brigade Rules, 2013.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, for rule 3 except the provisos thereunder, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

“3. Qualification for appointment to the Youth Brigade:-No person shall be eligible for appointment as a member of the Youth Brigade, unless he-

- (a) has passed the 10th standard examination;
- (b) is of sound health, active habits and free from any bodily defect or infirmity;
- (c) is a resident of Tamil Nadu;
- (d) has completed 18 years of age and has not completed 25 years of age as on 1st January of the year in which the selection for appointment is made;
- (e) has good character and antecedents;
- (f) does not have more than one wife living; and
- (g) has not involved in any criminal case before police verification.

*Explanation I:-*A person who is acquitted or discharged on benefit of doubt or due to the fact that the complainant turned hostile shall be treated as a person involved in a criminal case.

*Explanation II:-*A person involved in a criminal case at the time of police verification and the case yet to be disposed of and subsequently ended in honorable acquittal or treated as a mistake of fact shall be treated as not involved in a criminal case and he can claim right for appointment only by participating in the next recruitment”.
