Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Fisheries Service.

[G.O. Ms. No. 223, Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries (FS.2), 5th December 2018, Karthigai 19, Vilambi, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2049.]

No. SRO B-107/2018.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Fisheries Service (Section 14 in Vol.II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1970).

2. (i) Amendment (3) hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 15th September, 2016
(ii) All others amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 31st August 2017.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said Special Rules,-

(1) in rule 1,-

- (a) after the entry "Category 5 Assistant Director of Fisheries" the entry "Category 5-A Assistant Director of Fisheries (Mechanical)" shall be inserted.

(2) In rule 2,-

(a) in sub-rule(a), in the TABLE,-

- (i) in column (2), against the entries "4 Deputy Director of Fisheries (Engineering)" in column (1), for the entries in items (i), (ii) and (iii) the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

"By promotion from among the holders of the post of Assistant Director of Fisheries (Mechanical)".

- (ii) after the entries "5. Assistant Director of Fisheries" in column (1) and the corresponding entries relating thereto in column (2), the following entries shall respectively be inserted, namely:-

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- (iii) the entry "6. Fisheries Refrigeration Engineer" in column (1), and the corresponding entries relating thereto in column (2) shall be omitted.

(b) in sub-rule (c) for the entry "sub-rule (14) of rule 2 in part I preliminary of the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules" the entry "clause (r) under Section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016" shall be substituted.

(c) in the tabular column, under sub-rule(e),-

- (i) after the expression "Assistant Director of Fisheries" in column (1) and the corresponding entry relating thereto in column (2) the following entries shall respectively be inserted namely:-

"Assistant Director of Fisheries (Mechanical)	Director of Fisheries"
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- (ii) the entry "Fisheries Refrigeration Engineer" in column (1) and the corresponding entries relating thereto in column (2) shall be omitted.

(3) For rule 3, the following rule shall be substituted namely,-

3. Reservation of Appointment.- The provision contained in Section 27 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 (Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 2016) shall apply for appointment by direct recruitment to each category separately"

(a) for the expression "first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made" the expression "first day of July of the year in which the vacancy is notified" shall be substituted.

(b) in sub-ruler (b), for the expression "Fisheries Refrigeration Engineer" the expression "Assistant Director of Fisheries' (Mechanical)" shall be substituted.

(6) in rule 7,-

(a) in the TABLE,- (i) the entries "Deputy Director of Fisheries (Engineering)" in column (1) and the corresponding entries relating thereto in column (2) shall be omitted.

(ii) after the entry "Assistant Director of Fisheries" in column (1) and the entries relating thereto in column(2), the following entries shall respectively be inserted, namely;-

Amendments to the Tamil Nadu Travelling Allowance Rules.

[G.O. Ms. No. 397, Finance (Allowance), 14th December 2018, Karthigai 28, Vilambi, Thiruvalluvar Aandu–2049.]

No. SRO B-108/2018.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 read with Article 313 of the Constitution, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Tamil Nadu Travelling Allowance Rules.

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the **1st day of June 2009**.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said rules, -

1. in rule 17, for Note (1), (2), (3) and (4), the following Note shall be substituted, namely:-

“(1) The existing quantum of Fixed Travelling Allowance shall have enhanced by 100% sanctioned with effect from 1-9-1998 and which was not revised after 1-9-1998.

(2) The existing quantum of conveyance allowance paid to employee shall be enhanced by 100%.

(3) Consequent on the increase in the Basic Pay and taking note of the increase in Daily Allowance ordered in G.O. Ms. No.237, Finance Department, dated 01-06-2009, the existing monthly ceiling on Travelling Allowance shall be reduced from 20% to 10% of revised pay. Wherever the existing ceiling is 27% and 25%, it shall be reduced to 13% and 12% of revised pay.

(4) In respect of Officers having jurisdiction over more than one District and those having jurisdiction more than two Districts, the monthly ceiling shall be at 12% of pay and at 13% of pay, respectively.”.

2. for rule 29, including note (1) and (2), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“29. Eligibility for travel in different classes by Rail as follows:-

<i>Class of Travel by Rail</i> (1)	<i>Eligibility</i> (2)
Air Conditioned First Class	Grade-I Employees drawing Grade Pay of Rs.8,700 or more (including Officers of All India Service serving in the State).
First Class or Air Conditioned Two-Tier Class	Employees drawing Grade Pay of Rs.6,600 or more (including Officers of All India Service irrespective of the Grade Pay serving in the State).
First Class or Air Conditioned Three-Tier Class	Grade-II Employees drawing Grade Pay of Rs.4,400 and above but below Rs.6,600.
Second Class (Sleeper)	Grade-III and Grade-IV Employees drawing Grade Pay below Rs.4,400.

NOTE

(1) **Non Provision of First Class in Delhi bound trains:-** In case of rail journey to New Delhi where First Class is not available, travel in Air Conditioned two-tier class may be allowed to those Officers who are eligible for First Class.

(2) **Travel by Shatabdi Express:-** Government permit the following category of employees to undertake travel by Shatabdi Express while on tour or transfer except Leave Travel Concession journey:-

Ordinary Air Conditioned Chair Car.	Employees drawing Grade Pay Rs.6600 and above but below Rs.8900.

“37. A Government servant authorised by the Government to travel by air may draw the fare paid for the journey by air. If not so authorized, he can only draw the travelling allowance to which he would have been entitled, if he had gone by rail, Road or steamer.

No. SRO B-109/2018.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 read with Article 313 of the Constitution, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Tamil Nadu Travelling Allowance Rules.

2. The Amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 2017.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said rules, -

1. in rule 17, for Note (1), (2), (3) and (4), the following Note shall be substituted, namely:-

“(1) The existing quantum of Fixed Travelling Allowance shall have enhanced by 100% wherever it has not been enhanced after the last pay revision i.e. with effect from 1-6-2009 subject to rounding off to next 50 rupees. However, the quantum of Fixed Travelling Allowance allowed to employees on percentage of basic pay shall be reduced to 50%.

(2) The existing quantum of conveyance allowance paid to employee shall be enhanced by 100%.

(3) Consequent on the increase in the Basic Pay and taking note of the increase in Daily Allowance ordered in G.O.Ms. No.307, Finance (Pay Cell) Department, dated 13-10-2017, the existing monthly ceiling on Travelling Allowance shall be reduced from 10% to 5% of revised pay. Wherever the existing ceiling is 15% and 12%, it shall be reduced to 8% and 6% of revised pay.

(4) In respect of Officers having jurisdiction over more than one district and those having jurisdiction more than two districts, the monthly ceiling shall be at 6% of pay and at 7% of pay, respectively.”.
