No. SRO B-15/2018:—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Basic Service.

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 22nd December 2011.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules, in the Annexure,-

(1) Under CLASS I, under CATEGORY-4, under the heading "Miscellaneous Department", after the entry "Office of the Government Museum" in Column (1) and the corresponding entry " Director of Museum" in Column (2) there of, the entries "Office of the Commissioner, Tamil Nadu Food Safety and Drug Administration Department" and "Deputy Commissioner (Administration)" shall, respectively, be inserted;

(2) Under CLASS III, IV & V, under the heading "Miscellaneous Department", after the entry "Market Committees" in Column (1) and the corresponding entry "Secretaries of the Market Committee Concerned" in Column (2) there of, the entries "Office of the Tamil Nadu Food Safety and Drug Administration" and "Deputy Director (Administration)" shall, respectively, be added.

Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu School Educational Service.

No. SRO B-16/2018:— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu School Educational Service (Section 8-A in Volume-II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 2016)

2. The amendments hereby made shall come into force on and from the date of issue of the order.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules,

- (1) For rule 3, the following rule shall be substituted namely,

3. Reservation of appointments :-

Provisions contained in Section 27 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016, Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 2016 shall apply to appointments by direct recruitment to all the categories in the service, the appointments to each category being treated as one unit".

- (2) In the first proviso to sub-rule (i) of rule 6, the following expression shall be omitted, namely :-

"in respect of which the recruitment is made"

(3) In the Annexure, for entries in column (2) under the heading "Direct Recruitment" and for the entries in column (3), against the entries in column (1) under the heading "District Educational Officers, etc." the following entries shall respectively be substituted :-

"Direct recruitment" (otherwise than from among teachers employed in Recognised Aided Secondary Schools and Higher Secondary Schools)

Direct recruitment from among teachers employed in Recognised Aided Secondary Schools and Higher Secondary Schools

(i) A Master's degree of any University recognised by the University Grants Commission in the State or a degree of equivalent standard in anyone of the following subjects namely Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Botony, Zoology, Economics, Geography, History, Commerce, Tamil, English; and

(ii) should have studied Tamil under Part I or Part II of their intermediate or Pre-University course or Higher Secondary Course;

(iii) Bachelor of Teaching or Bachelor of Education of any recognized University in the State or a degree of equivalent standard;

(i) A Master's degree of any university recognized by the University Grants Commission in the State or a degree of equivalent standard in anyone of the following subjects namely Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Botony, Zoology, Economics, Geography, History, Commerce, Tamil, English; and

(ii) should have studied Tamil under Part I or Part II of their intermediate or Pre-University course or Higher Secondary Course; and

(iii) teaching experience for a period of not less than twelve years in a recognized school after acquiring the degree of Bachelor of Teaching or equivalent qualification.

Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Medical Services.

No. SRO B-17/2018.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Medical Services (Section 21, Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1969).

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force on the 7th September 2015.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said Special Rules, in Part II, under the heading Branch-I – Medical, -

(1) in rule 1, under Class V:-

(i) for the entry in Category 1, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

“Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Professor in Pharmaceutics, Professor in Pharmacognosy and Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.”;

(ii) for the entry in Category 2, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

“Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Associate Professor in Pharmaceutics, Associate Professor in Pharmacognosy and Associate Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.”;

(iii) the entry in Category-4 shall be omitted;

(iv) for the entry in Category 5, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

“Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutics, Assistant Professor in Pharmacognosy and Assistant Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.”;

(v) after Category-5, the following Category shall be added, namely:-

“Category 6 - Lecturer in Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges.”;

(2) in rule 3, in sub-rule (a), in the tabular column, under “Class V”,-

(i) in Category 1, for the entry in the first column and the corresponding entry in the second column thereof, the following entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:-

“Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Professor in Pharmaceutics, Professor in Pharmacognosy and Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

(i) By Promotion from the holders of the posts of Associate Professor in the respective speciality in Government Medical Colleges;

(ii) By direct recruitment, if no qualified candidate is available by the above method.”;

(ii) in Category 2, for the entry in the first column and the corresponding entry in the second column thereof, the following entries shall, respectively be, substituted, namely:-

“Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Associate Professor in Pharmaceutics, Associate Professor in Pharmacognosy and Associate Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

(i) By Promotion from the holders of the posts of Assistant Professor in the respective speciality in Government Medical Colleges.

(ii) By direct recruitment, if no qualified candidate is available by the above method.”;

(iii) in Category-4, the entry in the first column and the corresponding entry in the second column thereof, shall be omitted;

(iv) in Category-5, for the entry in the first column and the corresponding entries in the second column thereof, the following entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:-

“Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutics, Assistant Professor in Pharmacognosy and Assistant Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

(i) By transfer from the holders of the post of Lecturer in the respective speciality in Government Medical Colleges;

(ii) By direct recruitment, if no qualified candidate is available by the above method.”;

(v) after Category 5, the following category shall be added, namely:-

“Category-6-Lecturer in Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges

(i) By recruitment by transfer from any Category in the Tamil Nadu Medical Subordinate Service;

(ii) By direct recruitment, if no qualified candidate is available by the above method.”;

(3) in rule 7, in sub-rule (a), in the Table,-

(i) for the entries “Reader in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, in Pharmaceutics and in Pharmacology” and “Assistant Reader in Pharmaceutics, Pharmacognosy, Pharmaceutical Chemistry and Pharmacy” in column (1) and the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof, the following entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:-

“Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Professor in Pharmaceutics, Professor in Pharmacognosy and Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Associate Professor in Pharmaceutics, Associate Professor in Pharmacognosy and Associate Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

(ii) the entry “Non-Medical Assistant to the Reader in Medical Colleges” in Column (1) and the corresponding entry in Column (2) thereof, shall be omitted;

(iii) for the entry "Tutor in Pharmacy" in column (1) and the corresponding entry in column (2), the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutics, Assistant Professor in Pharmacognosy and Assistant Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.	30 years

(iv) after the above entry, the following entry shall be added, namely:-

"Lecturer in Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges"	30 years"

(4) in rule 9, -

(i) in sub-rule (b), in clause (ii), for the sixth proviso, the following provisos shall be substituted, namely:-

"Provided also that a person appointed by promotion to the post of Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Professor in Pharmaceutics, Professor in Pharmacognosy and Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges need not undergo probation.

Provided also that a person appointed by promotion to the post of Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Associate Professor in Pharmaceutics Associate Professor in Pharmacognosy and Associate Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges need not undergo probation:";

(ii) in sub-rule (d),-

(a) for the entry "(3) Reader in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Reader in Pharmaceutics and Reader in Pharmacognosy", the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

"(3) Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Professor in Pharmaceutics, Professor in Pharmacognosy and Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.";

(b) for the entry "(4) Assistant Reader in Pharmaceutics, Pharmacognosy, Pharmaceutical Chemistry and Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges", the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

"(4) Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Associate Professor in Pharmaceutics, Associate Professor in Pharmacognosy and Associate Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.";

(c) the entry "(5) Non Medical Assistant to the Reader in Pharmacology in Medical Colleges" shall be omitted;

(d) for the entry "(6) Tutor in Pharmacy", the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

"(6) Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutics Assistant Professor in Pharmacognosy and Associate Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

(e) after the entry (6), the following entry shall be added, namely:-

"(6A) Lecturer in Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges.";

(5) in rule 10,-

(i) in sub-rule (a),-

(a) for the entry "Assistant Readers in Pharmaceutics, Pharmacognosy, Pharmaceutical Chemistry and Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges", the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Associate Professor in Pharmaceutics, Associate Professor in Pharmacognosy and Associate Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

Before the entry Assistant Reader and after the entry Assistant Reader the following entries shall be added:

"Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Professor in Pharmaceutics, Professor in Pharmacognosy and Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutics, Assistant Professor in Pharmacognosy and Assistant Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

Lecturer in Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges:”

(b) after the eighth proviso, the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

“Provided also that every person appointed by recruitment by transfer to the post of Lecturer in Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges, shall pass the Account Test for Executive Officers within a period of two years from the date of their appointment, failing which increments in the time scale of pay shall be withheld without cumulative effect, till they pass the said test.”;

(ii) in sub-rule (c), after the seventh proviso, the following provisos shall be added, namely:-

“Provided also that every person appointed to the posts of Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Professor in Pharmaceutics, Professor in Pharmacognosy, Professor in Pharmacology, Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Associate Professor in Pharmaceutics, Associate Professor in Pharmacognosy, Associate Professor in Pharmacology, Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutics, Assistant Professor in Pharmacognosy and Assistant Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges by direct recruitment shall pass the Departmental Test in the Tamil Nadu Medical Code within a period of four years from the date of his appointment to the said post, failing which increments in the time scale of pay shall be withheld without cumulative effect, till he passes the said test:

Provided also that every person appointed to the post of Lecturer in Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges by direct recruitment or by recruitment by transfer shall pass the Departmental Test in the Tamil Nadu Medical Code within a period of four years from the date of his appointment to the said post, failing which increments in the time scale of pay will be withheld without cumulative effect till he passes the said test.”;

(6) in rule 13, in sub-rule (a),-

(i) for the entry “Reader in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, in Pharmaceutics and in Pharmacognosy.”, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

“Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Professor in Pharmaceutics, Professor in Pharmacognosy and Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.”;

(ii) for the entry “Assistant Reader in Pharmaceutics, Pharmacognosy, Pharmaceutical Chemistry and Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges.”, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

“Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Associate Professor in Pharmaceutics, Associate Professor in Pharmacognosy and Associate Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.”;

(iii) the entry “Non Medical Assistant to the Reader in Pharmacology in Medical Colleges.” shall be omitted;

(iv) for the entry “Tutor in Pharmacy.”, the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

“Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutics, Assistant Professor in Pharmacognosy and Assistant Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

(v) After the entry, the following entry shall be added, namely:-

“Lecturer in Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges”.

(7) in rule 14, in sub rule (a), in clause (1), for the entry “(v) Reader in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, in Pharmaceutics and in Pharmacognosy.”, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

“(v) Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Professor in Pharmaceutics, Professor in Pharmacognosy and Professor in Pharmacology.

(va) Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Associate Professor in Pharmaceutics, Associate Professor in Pharmacognosy and Associate Professor in Pharmacology.”

(8) in the Annexure,-

(i) under the heading “Class V, Category 1”, for the entry in column (1) and corresponding entry in column (2) thereof, the following entries shall, respectively, be, substituted, namely:-

“Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Professor in Pharmaceutics, Professor in Pharmacognosy and Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.”

(1) By promotion:

- (i) Must have obtained Ph.D., degree (with First Class degree either in B.Pharm or M.Pharm) in the appropriate branch of specialization in Pharmacy; and
- (ii) Must have put in ten years experience in Teaching, out of which not less than five years shall be at the level of Associate Professor:

Provided that a person holding the post of Associate Professor on 07-09-2015 possessing first class degree either in B.Pharm or M.Pharm Degree with ten years experience in teaching, out of which five years experience at the level of Associate Professor in the respective branch shall be promoted as Professor, subject to the condition that he shall acquire Ph.D., degree within a period of seven years from the date of appointment as Professor, failing which the annual increment from the 8th year and subsequent increments shall be withheld in the present post till they acquire Ph.D. Degree.

(2) By direct recruitment:

- (i) Must have obtained Ph.D. degree (with First Class degree either in B.Pharm or M.Pharm) in the appropriate branch of specialization in Pharmacy; and
- (ii) Must have put in ten years experience in teaching, out of which not less than five years shall be at the level of Associate Professor:

Provided that a person holding the post of Associate Professor on 07-09-2015 possessing first class degree either in B.Pharm or M.Pharm Degree with ten years experience in teaching, out of which five years experience at the level of Associate Professor in the respective branch shall be appointed as Professor, subject to the condition that he shall acquire Ph.D., degree within a period of seven years from the date of appointment as Professor, failing which the annual increment from the eighth year and subsequent increments shall be withheld in the present post till they acquire Ph.D. Degree.”;

(ii) under the heading “Class V, Category 2”, for the entry in column (1) and the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof, the following entries shall respectively, be substituted, namely:-

“Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Associate Professor in Pharmaceutics, Associate Professor in Pharmacognosy and Associate Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

(1) By promotion:

- (i) Must have obtained Ph.D., degree (with First Class degree either in B.Pharm or M.Pharm) in the appropriate branch of specialization in Pharmacy; and
- (ii) Must have put in five years experience in Teaching at the level of Assistant Professor:

Provided that a person holding the post of Assistant Professor on 07-09-2015 possessing first class degree either in B.Pharm or M.Pharm with five years experience in teaching, at the level of Assistant Professor in the respective branch shall be promoted as Associate Professor, subject to the condition that he shall acquire Ph.D. degree within a period of seven years from the date of appointment as

Associate Professor, failing which the annual increment from the eighth year and subsequent increments shall be withheld in the present post till they acquire Ph.D Degree.

(2) By direct recruitment:

- (i) Must have obtained Ph.D. degree (with First Class degree either in B.Pharm or M.Pharm) in the appropriate branch of specialization in Pharmacy; and
- (ii) Must have put in five years experience in Teaching at the level of Assistant Professor:

Provided that a person holding the post of Assistant Professor on possessing first class degree either in B.Pharm or M.Pharm with five years experience in teaching, at the level of Assistant Professor in the respective branch shall be appointed as Associate Professor, subject to the condition that he shall acquire Ph.D., degree within a period of seven years from the date of appointment as Associate Professor, failing which the annual increment from the eighth year and subsequent increments shall be withheld in the present post till they acquire Ph.D. Degree.”;

(iii) the heading “Class V, Category 4” and the entries thereunder in columns (1) and (2) shall be omitted;

(iv) under the heading “Class V, Category 5”, for the entry in column (1) and the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof, the following entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:-

“Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Assistant Professor in Pharmaceutics, Assistant Professor in Pharmacognosy and Assistant Professor in Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.

(1) By Promotion:

Must have obtained M.Pharm degree in the appropriate branch of specialisation in Pharmacy with first class either in B.Pharm or M.Pharm.

(2) By direct recruitment:

Must have obtained a M.Pharm degree in the appropriate branch of specialisation in Pharmacy with first class either in B.Pharm or M.Pharm.

(v) after the heading “Class V, Category 5”, the following entry in columns (1) and (2) shall, respectively, be added namely:-

“Class V, Category-6 Lecturer in Pharmacy in Government Medical Colleges.

(1) By recruitment by transfer:

Must have obtained M.Pharm Degree or B.Pharm Degree

(Preference will be given to M.Pharm)

(2) By direct recruitment:

Must have obtained M.Pharm Degree or B.Pharm Degree
