Amendment to the Adhoc Rules Relating to Post of Epigraphist, Exploration-cum-Excavation Archaeologist, Pre-Historic Archaeologist, Curator and Archaeological Officer in the Department of Archaeology in Tamil Nadu General Subordinate Services.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Adhoc Rules issued with the Education, Science and Technology Department Notification S.R.O No. B-365 of 1988, published at page 252 of Part III—Section 1(b) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated the 19th October 1988.

The amendments hereby made shall come into force on and from the date of issue of this order.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said Rules .-

(1) for rule1, the following rule shall be substituted, namely,-

"The Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016, (Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 2016) and the Special rules applicable to the holders of the permanent posts in the Tamil Nadu General Subordinate Service shall apply to the holders of the posts of Epigraphist, Exploration-*cum*-Excavation Archaeologist, Pre-Historic Archaeologist and Curator in the Department of Archaeology, Chennai, subject to the modifications specified in the following rules."

- (2) in rule 2, after the existing entries, the following entries shall be added, namely,-
 - "The post of Archaeological Officer is also interchangeable"
- (3) for rule 3, the following rule shall be substituted, namely,-
 - "3. Appointment: Appointment to the posts shall be made:-
 - (i) By promotion from among the holders of the post of Junior Epigraphist and Technical Assistant (Geology);

(or)

(ii) By recruitment by transfer from any other service;

(or)

- (iii) By direct recruitment;
- (4) in rule 3A, for the entry "1st July" the entry "1st September" shall be substituted.
- (5) in rule 4, for the expression "Director" the expression "Commissioner/Director" shall be substituted
- (6) in rule 5 for sub-rule (b), the following rule shall be substituted, namely,-
- (b) Other Qualification: No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by the method specified in column (1) of the table below unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof:-

- (iii) Must have passed Tamil as one of the subjects in Degree level.
- (7) for rule 5A, the following rule shall be substituted, namely,-

"5A. Reservation of Appointment

Section 27 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act 2016, (Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 2016)" shall apply for appointment to the posts by direct recruitment."

(8) in rule 6, after the existing entries the following proviso shall be added, namely,-

"Provided that every person appointed to the post by recruitment by transfer shall from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a period of one year within a continuous period of two years"

(9) in rule 8, the following proviso shall be added, namely,-

"Nothing contained in these rules shall adversely affect the interest of the persons holding the posts on the date of publication of these rules in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*."

 - (i) By promotion from among the holders of the post of Junior Epigraphist and Technical Assistant (Geology);

(or)

(ii) By recruitment by transfer from any other service;

(or).

- (iii) By direct recruitment
- (4) after rule 3, the following rule shall be added, namely:-

3-A For the purpose of preparation of annual list of approved candidates for appointment to the post the crucial date on which the candidate should have acquired the prescribed qualification to hold the post by promotion and recruitment by transfer shall be the 1st September of every year.

- (5) in rule 4, for the expression "Director" the expression "Commissioner/Director" shall be substituted.
