No. SRO B-66/2019.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Forest Service (Section 15 in Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 2016).

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 17th July 2018.

#### AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules, in rule 4, in sub-rule (1), in clause (a),-

- (1) for the expressions “the age of thirty years”, and “the selection by appointment is made” the expressions “the age of thirty two years” and “the vacancy is notified” shall, respectively, be substituted;
- (2) in the first proviso, for the expression “thirty five years”, the expression “thirty seven years” shall be substituted.

#### Amendments to the Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules.

No. SRO B-67/2019.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules:-

#### AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules, in rule 8,-

- (1) after clause (ix), the following provisos shall be added, namely:-

“Provided that in every case in which,

- (i) the charge of possession of assets disproportionate to known sources of income; or
- (ii) the charge of acceptance from any person of any gratification, other than legal remuneration, as a motive or reward for doing or forbearing to do any official act; or
- (iii) the charge of giving an undue advantage with an intention to induce a public servant to perform or not to perform a public duty or to reward the public servant for the performance or non-performance of a public duty is proved, the penalty mentioned in clause (vii) or clause (viii) shall be imposed;

Provided further that in any exceptional case and for special reasons recorded in writing, any other penalty may be imposed”;

- (2) after Explanation-III, the following Explanation shall be added, namely:-

“Explanation-IV.-The term “public servant” in this rule, shall have the same meaning as defined in the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (Central Act 49 of 1988)”.

No. SRO B-68/2019.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Rules:-

2. (i) The Rules hereby made for the post of Principal, All India Civil Services Coaching Centre shall be deemed to have come into force on the 2nd September, 2005.

(ii) The Rules hereby made for the post of Principal, Competitive Examinations Coaching Centre shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th September, 2017.

(iii) The Rules hereby made for the post of Assistant Professor shall be deemed to have come into force on the 14th July, 1966.

RULES
