Draft Amendment to the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles (Regulation and Control of School Buses) Special Rules, 2012.

[G.O. Ms. No. 342, Home (Transport-VII), 16th September 2020.]

No. SRO A-37/2020.—The following draft amendment to the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles (Regulation and Control of School Buses) Special Rules, 2012, which is proposed to be made in exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (xxxiii) of sub-section (2) of Section 96, Section 111, and sub-section (2) of Section 138 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), is hereby published for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, as required by sub-section (1) of Section 212 of the said Act:

2. Notice is hereby given that the draft amendment will be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of a period of thirty days from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, and that any objection or suggestion, which may be received from any person with respect thereto before the expiry of the aforesaid period will be considered by the Government of Tamil Nadu.

3. Objection or suggestion, if any, should be addressed in duplicate to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Home, P&E Department, Secretariat, Chennai-600 009.

DRAFT AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 8, in sub-rule (2), in clause (iii), for the expression "three months", the expression "six months" shall be substituted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

1. Presently most of the schools are operating recent buses with various facilities to attract students and parents.

2. School Buses are produced two times in a year for inspection and also one time for obtaining fitness certificate before the Regional Transport Office/Unit Offices. Hence the school buses are inspected either for 2 times or 3 times in a year. It may be sufficient for inspection of the school buses. The notification aims at achieving the aforesaid object.
