No.SRO A-14/2021.— The following draft amendment to the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 111 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988) is hereby published for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, as required by sub-section (1) of Section 212 of the said Act.

- 2. Notice is hereby given that the draft amendment will be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of the period of thirty days from the date of publication of this draft Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* and that any objection or suggestion, which may be received from any person with respect thereto before the date of expiry of the aforesaid period will be considered by the Government of Tamil Nadu.

DRAFT AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 364, after the proviso, the following proviso shall be added namely:-

"Provided further that every battery operated auto rickshaw shall be painted in bottle green colour on all sides of the body of the vehicle with a highway yellow band of fifteen centimetres in width on the central portion of the body of the vehicle".
