

Amendment to Sub Rule 2 of Rule 5 of the Madras High Court Designation of Senior Advocates Rules, 2020, Framed by the High Court

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 34 (1) *read* with Section 16 (2) of the Advocates Act, 1961, the High Court of Judicature at Madras, hereby makes the following amendment to Sub Rule 2 of Rule 5 of the Madras High Court Designation of Senior Advocates Rules, 2020, as published in *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, Part III-Section 2, Issue No. 29, dated 15-07-2020 and subsequent Amendment made to Rule 10 of the Madras High Court Designation of Senior Advates Rules, 2020 published in *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, Part III-Section 2, Issue No. 3, dated 20-01-2021.

AMENDMENT

For Sub Rule 2 of Rule 5 of the Madras High Court Designation of Senior Advocates Rules, 2020, the following Rule shall be substituted namely:-

"5. Modes of Proposal & Method of Submission:-

5(1)

(a)
(b)
(c)

5(2) (a) No Judge shall propose names of more than two Advocates for designation in one calendar year.

(b) No Senior Advocate having a standing of 15 years as Senior Advocate shall propose under clause (b) of sub-rule (1) / endorse under clause (c) of sub-rule (1) / propose and endorse under clauses (b) and (c) of sub-rule (1) more than two Advocates in all for designation in one calendar year.

Explanation — For the purposes of this sub rule, proposal shall be construed as endorsement and endorsement shall be construed as proposal."
