Mandatory Aadhaar Authentication of the beneficiaries/users/Sports persons/other Sports related beneficiaries under Section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targated Delivery of Financial and other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016.

No. II(1)/YWSD/35/2022.— WHEREAS, the use of Aadhaar as an identity document for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency and enables beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly in a convenient and seamless manner by obviating the need to produce multiple documents to prove one's identity;

AND WHEREAS, the Youth Welfare and Sports Development Department (hereinafter referred to as the Department), is administering the Special Scholarship for Elite Sportspersons (ESP), Special Scholarship for Mission International Medal Scheme (MIMS), Special Scholarship for Champion Development Scheme (CDS), High Cash Incentive to the medal winners in the National and International level competitions, Prize Money to first three winners in the State Game's for Chief Minster's Trophy, Prize money to Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu competitions, Cash Award to Chief Minister's State Sports Award and Cash Award to Chief Minister's State Youth Award (hereinafter referred to as 'the Scheme'), which is being implemented through the Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu (hereafter referred to as the Implementing Agency);

AND WHEREAS, under the Scheme, Cash Incentive or Prize Money (hereinafter referred to as the benefit) is given to every eligible sportsperson / youth by the Implementing Agency as per the extant Scheme guidelines;

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid Scheme involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of the State of Tamil Nadu;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of Section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (Central Act 18 of 2016) (hereinafter referred to as 'the said Act'), the Government of Tamil Nadu hereby notifies the following, namely:

1. (1) An individual eligible for receiving the benefits under the Scheme shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.

(2) Any individual desirous of availing benefits under the Scheme, who does not possess the Aadhaar number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrolment before registering for the Scheme, provided that he/she is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per Section 3 of the said Act and such individual shall visit any Aadhaar enrolment centre (list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) website www.uidai.gov.in) to get enrolled for Aadhaar.

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, benefits under the Scheme shall be given to such individual subject to the production of the following documents in original, namely:

- (a) If he has enrolled, his Aadhaar Enrolment Identification Slip; and
- (b) Any one of the following documents, namely: -
 - (i) Bank or Post Office Passbook with Photo; or
 - (ii) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card; or
 - (iii) Passport; or
 - (iv) Voter Identity Card; or
 - (v) Driving license issued by the Licensing Authority Under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988); or
 - (vi) Certificate of identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tahsildar on an Official letter head; or
 - (vii) Any other document specified by the State Government

Provided further that the above documents may be checked by an officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

2. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Scheme conveniently, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the said requirement.

(a) In all cases, authentication by Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-Based One-Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered, and

(b) If (a) is not possible, benefits under the Scheme may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the Quick Response code printed on the Aadhaar Card in original and necessary arrangement of Quick Response Code reader shall be provided at the convenient locations by the Department through its Implementing Agency.

3. In addition to the above, in order to ensure that no bonafide beneficiary under the Scheme is deprived of his due benefits, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall follow the exception handling mechanism as outlined in the Office Memorandum of Direct Benefit Transfer Mission, Cabinet Secretariat, Government of India, dated the 9th December 2017.

4. This Notification shall come into effect from the date of its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.
