Amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Marketing Subordinate Service

No.SRO B-9/2022.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 22 of the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Produce Marketing (Regulation) Act, 1987 (Tamil Nadu Act 27 of 1989) and the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Marketing Subordinate Service.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 6th June, 2012.

AMENDMENT

In the said Special Rules, in rule 4, in sub-rule (b), in the TABLE, for the entry in item (i) in column (3) against “Category-1” in column (1) and the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

“Must have put in service for a period of not less than three years in the post of Supervisor in category-3”.

No.SRO B-10/2022.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 read with Article 313 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Tamil Nadu Leave Rules, 1933 contained in Annexure-III to the Fundamental Rules.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 13th May 2021.

AMENDMENT

In the said Tamil Nadu Leave Rules, 1933, in rule 7A, in the first proviso, for the expression, “for a period of one year from the 27th April 2020”, the expression “for a period of two years from 27th April 2020 till 31st March 2022” shall be substituted.
